
English

Geography


In order to link in with our 'Explorers' topic we will be developing our map making skills by looking at our understanding our the local area

Maths

We will start Term 4 by exploring subtraction within 20. We will also be developing our understanding of 'fact families' before returning to place value, this time within 50. Before ending the term on measurement, including length, mass and volume.

Our daily counting practise will be focusing on counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.

Music

Music and movement sessions will be held weekly.

Science
