As Mathematicians, we will develop our fluency, reasoning and problem solving skills. In particular, we will develop our understanding of place value and apply this knowledge to solving number problems.

We will practise counting on and back in steps of 1, 2, 5 and 10

Science

As young scientists, we will investigate how can we work out what's alive and what's not. Collect specimens and sort them into categories. Investigate habitats and food chains. Design and make a bug hotel made up of different microhabitats to encourage a variety of creatures we can investigate!
